

The Pauline Webb Ecumenical Fund

Do you have the opportunity to attend an ecumenical event? but can't afford the cost? and your Church can't fund you? The Pauline Webb Fund may be able to help

Who can to apply?

To be eligible, you need to be:

- A woman, normally resident in Britain or Ireland, and a member of a church that is in membership of CTBI or one of the national ecumenical instruments
- Commended by your church, one of the ecumenical bodies, or one of the Christian women's organisations linked them

Preference is given to:

Women having a first or second experience of an ecumenical event

- Women under 40
- Women from ethnic minorities
- Women with expertise but who cannot be funded by their churches
- Encouraging participation of women from across England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales

Please note:

- Grants do not normally exceed 75% of the cost of the conference
- Decisions on the awarding of grants are made by the trustees of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland

How to apply for a grant

There is no application form. To apply, please provide:

- **1.** Details of the ecumenical conference or consultation that you wish to attend and its objectives
- **2.** The nature of the contribution you believe you will be able to offer to the event and the benefits that you think you will receive from it
- **3.** Details of the costs of travel, conference fees and accommodation, together with any information about money you may be able to obtain from other sources
- 4. Details of your church or other recommending body

Successful applicants are also asked to write and submit a 2 page A4 report on the event attended. This should give an impression of the event, indicate what contribution you made and highlight the value to you of the experience.
